## TRADE UNION RESPONSES - POLICIES

CAMPAIGNED FOR RATIFICATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF ILO CONVENTIONS (182,138, 184, 141,29) AND LABOUR LAW ACT 651, CHILDREN'S ACT 560, CHILD TRAFFICKING ACT 694 etc.

DEVELOPMENT OF WORKPLACE POLICIES ie CLAUSES IN COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS (CBAs) (WHERE TRADE UNIONS EXIST CHILD LABOUR IS ABSENT)

WORK DESIGN AND ARRANGEMENT DISCOURAGES
CHILD LABOUR – WHEN ONE CHILD GETS A JOB ONE
ADULT IS DENIED THAT JOB
ERODING LABOUR GAINS – CHILDREN HAVE WEAK
NEGOTIATING POWER
