Rubrics for UG and PGT Papers 2024/25

UG and PGT exam papers in Informatics use the following rubric:

Candidates should answer TWO questions out of THREE.
If all three questions are attempted only the first two answers will be marked.
Each question is worth 50 marks.
Time allowed: TWO hours.

Exceptions to this are as follows:

Level 3

Mathematics for Computing 1/Mathematics for Computing 2

Candidates should answer ALL of the questions.
Each question is worth the same number of marks.

Calculators are permitted.
A mathematical formula sheet is provided.
Credit will be given for correct working even if the final answer is not correct.

Level 5

Philosophical Foundations of Cognitive Science

Candidates answer TWO questions out of SIX.
Each question is worth 50 marks

Level 6

Philosophy of Science and Consciousness

Candidates answer TWO questions out of EIGHT.
Each question is worth 50 marks.
